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**GREEN MOUNTAIN POWER POST-WORKSHOP COMMENTS**

Green Mountain Power (“GMP”) submits these follow-up comments to the November 15, 2021 workshop in the above-referenced matter regarding the Standard Offer Program.

GMP supports actual deployment of the full 127.5 MW capacity from the Standard Offer Program set forth in 30 V.S.A. § 8005a(c) and recognizes that there likely will be some projects after the 2022 RFP process that do not reach commissioning. GMP believes the Department of Public Service’s suggestions to achieve 127.5 MW of project deployment are reasonable; specifically, that if additional capacity is needed to achieve that deployment, the Commission should let the Reserve Group for 2022 be maintained beyond the current year to provide replacement capacity if an awarded project does not move forward. The Commission also could conduct one or more supplemental auctions after 2022 as needed.

GMP appreciates the opportunity to participate in the workshop and to comment on this matter.
