**ORDER RE AMENDED PROCEDURES FOR ELECTRONIC
FILING AND CASE MANAGEMENT**

The Vermont Public Utility Commission² (“PUC” or “Commission”) is authorized, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 11a, to implement an electronic filing and case management system for proceedings conducted before the Commission (“ePUC”).

On December 23, 2016, the Commission adopted procedures governing the use of ePUC (the “procedures”).

In today’s order, the Commission adopts amendments to the December 23, 2016, procedures.

The procedures have been amended to: 1) add net-metering registrations, applications, and petitions, as well as applications for non-net-metering renewable energy facilities with a capacity of 150 kW or less, to the types of cases that are eligible for processing in ePUC; 2) clarify that the hard copies required to be filed with the Commission pursuant to ePUC Pr. Section I(d) may be filed within one business day of the day of an electronic filing made using ePUC; and 3) rearrange the definitions to be in alphabetical order given the name change to Public Utility Commission.


The attached amended procedures for the implementation of the Vermont Public Utility Commission’s electronic filing and case management system are hereby adopted.

1. Formerly known as “ePSB.” Pursuant to section 9 of Act 53 of the 2017 legislative session, the Vermont Public Service Board’s name was changed to Vermont Public Utility Commission effective July 1, 2017, necessitating the name change from ePSB to ePUC.

2. Formerly known as the Vermont Public Service Board.
