ORDER ANNOUNCING WEBINAR SERIES

On September 17, 2021, the Vermont Public Utility Commission ("Commission") opened this proceeding to develop rules governing the installation and operation of energy storage facilities in Vermont.¹

In today's order, the Commission announces that it will be hosting a five-part webinar series in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Energy Office of Electricity Energy Storage Program and Sandia National Laboratories covering a variety of energy storage topics to assist in the development of Vermont's energy storage rules.
